## What is the Grant for?

The *Create Real Impact* grant will be awarded to California schools who find innovative ways to utilize the Impact Teen Drivers program or materials. This is designed to engage kids and allow Impact Teen Drivers to become a student-led program that empowers teens and allows them to practice leadership while developing meaningful programs for their peers.

## Who Can Apply?

Any California student grades 10-12, any high school teacher or high school administrator .

## What kinds of projects will be considered?

Whether it's a PSA put together by the video productions class, a collective project by an art class, or a teacher-led school service project, Impact Teen Drivers wants to see original and inventive ways schools use our program to reach teen drivers and help them make good decisions behind the wheel. All student-led projects must involve a teacher or administrator as an advisor throughout the project.

## What is the grant amount?

Ten different high schools will be awarded \$1,000 each for this competitive grant. Schools may submit more than one project, but each school can receive only one grant.

## How do I apply?
